#### Allah is Ever-Living and Eternal

"He is the First and the Last, the Ascendant and the Intimate, and He has full knowledge of all things." (S 57:3)

It is Narrated by Ibn Abbas RZ that: When the Prophet sent Mu'adh to Yemen, he said to him, "You are going to a nation from the people of the Scripture, so let the first thing to which you will invite them, be the Tauhid of Allah. If they learn that, tell them that Allah has enjoined on them, five prayers to be offered in one day and one night. And if they pray, tell them that Allah has enjoined on them Zakat of their properties and it is to be taken from the rich among them and given to the poor. And if they agree to that, then take from them Zakat but avoid the best property of the people."

Sahih Al-Bukhaari: 7372

The Prophet sent Muadh to Yemen and said, "Invite the people to testify that none has the right to be worshipped but Allah and I am (Muhammad) Allah's Messenger , and if they obey you to do so, then teach them that

Allah has enjoined on them five prayers in every day and night, and if they obey you to do so, then teach them that Allah has made it obligatory for them to pay the Zakat from their property and it is to be taken from the wealthy among them and given to the poor."

Sahih Al-Bukhaari: 1395, Sahih Al-Muslim: 19

It is Narrated by Abdullah son of Umar RZ that The Prophet said: Al-Islam is raised on five (pillars), testifying that there is no god but Allah, that Muhammad is His bondsman and messenger, and the establishment of prayer, payment of Zakat, Pilgrimage to the House (Ka'ba) and the fast of Ramazan.

Mahdavis who, under all conditions, are desirous of Allah's pleasure and declare the kalima of "La Ilaha Ill Allah Muhammadur Rasoolullah "with their tongues and accept It in their hearts and perform the obligations

(faraiz) which are proven by the Book of Allah and the sayings of the Prophet .\*

The Sayings of Hz Syed Muhammad (Jaunpuri) Imam Mahdi Mauod AS confirm that the purpose of his advent was dissemination of monotheism (Tauheed)

Once Imam AS said: "I have presented the Book of Allah, and inviting the people towards belief in the unity of Allah (Tauheed) and devotion (Ibadat), and I have been deputed by Allah for this very purpose." (Insaf Nama)

#### It is cited in the book 'Makhzan-Ud Dalail' that:

"He used to ask the people to worship Allah who is only one, and do not associate anyone with Allah visibly and invisibly, and he (Mahdi) commands all the people to keep away from everything other than justice, good deed (Ihsan) and righteousness..."

# He had spread the practical form of Tauheed among his followers, such as he said:

"Whatever you want, ask it from Allah, do not seek it from the people. If you want to ask, ask from Allah." (Insaf Nama)

# It is cited in 'Hashia Insaf Nama', in which Hz Mahdi AS said that the objective of all the books revealed by Allah is Tauheed, and he invited the people towards it

"Hz Mahdi AS said that I am stating the objective of the Torah (Tauret), Bible (Injeel), psalms (Zaboor), the Holy Quran and the unity of Allah in only one sentence, that Laa Ilaha Ill Allah (There is none worthy of worship except Allah) is the objective of all these things."

Hz Syed Muhammad Mahdi Mauod AS has made it clear in this narration that the belief in unity of Allah (Tauheed) has been taught in all the books revealed on His prophets including the Holy Quran.

Hence, The Mahdavis sincerely believe and recite The 'Kalma - E Tauheed' that: "There is no God but Allah, The only One who has no participant. The kingdom (of Universe) belongs to Him And all the praise is due unto Him. It is He who gives life and causes death; And He is Alive, Who never ever dies; The Possessor of Majesty and Grace; In His Hand is all the good And He it is Who Has Power over everything."
